


### TOTAL AIR EXPORTS (IN TONS) MONTH ON MONTH



- Compared to 2022, 2023 Oct / Nov / Dec has shown minor increased in monthly numbers.
- Overall, when looking at the performance of the entire year, it is a very minor increase from 2020 compared to previous years. The reasons for this downturn were the huge downturn in the garment sector and import restrictions.



### Total Air Exports (In Tons) Quarterly




- Looking at the last 5 years, Q4 of 2023 will see growth only higher than 2022 and 2020. Compared
  to other years, the data for Q4 2023 is very low.
- The reasons for this very slow growth curve are many garment factories leaving Sri Lanka and going to other countries, and the very rapid changes in the price of infrastructure. With this, the price of the product is not at a certain level because the manufacturers have not been able to set a certain price. Due to this, the demand for Sri Lankan products has decreased.

### Total Air Imports (In Tons) Month on Month




- The imports in the months of Oct, Nov, Dec in 2023 has seen a very minor increase in comparison with 2022, but
  in comparison with 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021, the imports in the months of Oct, Nov, Dec 2023 is very low. Which
  mean even in Covid period of 2020 did imports more than this year.
- The reason behind this decreasing would be import restriction that implanted by the LK government, the reduction of sea freight rates and the rapid price fluctuation of infrastructure.

### Total Air Imports (In Tons) Quarterly




- A clear increase can be seen in Q4 compared to other Quarters of 2023.
- The main reason for this could be the removal of import restrictions.
- But in comparison with other years, although the year 2023 shows an increase compared to the year 2022, it is very low compared to the years 2018, 2019, 2020, 2021.

### Total Air Transshipments (In Tons) Quarterly



- Compared to the 2020, 2022 years, Q4 of 2023 can see a huge increase.
- But in comparison with the years 2018 2019 2021, it is a big setback. Due to the reasons for this, the continuous technical faults in UL flights greatly affected the decrease in demand.

### Air Freight Throughput (Exports, Imports & Transshipments) in Ton's Yearly



- Data shown for the years from 2018 to 2023.
- In addition to the facts mentioned in the above slide, the fall in the rates of the ocean freight industry, rapid price fluctuation of infrastructure has also had a strong impact on the collapse of the air freight industry.



- Laden containers of Q4 in 2023 has shows minor increased compared to last year while Empty containers of Q4 has shows major increased. But compared to 2019 to 2021 it has shows minor decrease.
- This apparent collapse of the ocean freight industry has been heavily influenced by the massive collapse in the apparel sector.




• We can see a decrease in empty containers, which reached a very high value in 2022, in all quarters of this year.

### Total Ocean Imports in TEUs Yearly


