



TOTAL AIR EXPORTS (IN TONS) MONTH ON MONTH




- Compared to 2023 Jan / Feb / Mar 2024 export has shown 35% increase.
- After Mar 2022, Feb 2024 exported more than 10,000 Tons in singular month.
- According to the above data, we have seen that the downturn in the export industry is over, and it is picking up again.

Total Air Exports (In Tons) Quarterly




- After Q1 in 2022, 2024 Q1 exported more than 30,000 tons.
- According to the above data, the decline seen throughout the year 2023 is concluded and it shows that it will rise again at the beginning of this year.

Total Air Imports (In Tons) Month on Month




- The minor increase seen in the import in months of October, November and December 2023 again showed something lower in January and February 2024, but it shows higher again in March.
- After January 2022, 4000 tons have been imported again in March 2024.

Total Air Imports (In Tons) Quarterly




- A clear increase can be seen in Q1 compared to previous year.



- Laden containers of Q1 in 2024 has shows 17.11% increased compared to last year while Empty containers of Q4 has shows major increased. But compared to 2021 and 2022 it has shows minor decrease.
- This apparent revival of the ocean freight industry has been heavily influenced by the stability of Sri Lanka economy.

Total Ocean Exports in TEUs Yearly




Above data shown from years from 2020 to 2024.

- We can see a decrease in empty containers, which reached a very high value in 2022.


Total Ocean Imports in TEUs Yearly



- Compared to last 2 years ocean transshipment increased in every first 3 months.
- For this increased heavily influenced by red sea war, stability in Sri Lanka economy.

- 2024 Q1 performed the most amount of transshipment since 2022.
- Compared to 2023 Q1 it is a 21.8% increment and compared to 2022 Q1 it is a 10.3% increment.
